



FRANCISCAN PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND & JORDAN

June 11-21, 2017

GEORGE'S

Day 1 - Sunday, June 11: Depart U.S.A.

Our spiritual pilgrimage begins as we depart on our transatlantic overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 - Monday, June 12: Arrive Tel Aviv / Jerusalem

After arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, we'll be welcomed by our Franciscan spiritual director who will accompany us throughout our pilgrimage in the Holy Land and make the Scripture come alive as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Board our motorcoach and drive to Jerusalem, our home for the next four nights. (D)

Day 3 - Tuesday, June 13: Jerusalem

After breakfast this morning we will enjoy a tour of Bethlehem including visits to the Nativity Church which was built above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth, the Manger, the Grotto of St. Jerome, the Church of St. Catherine, and the Shepherds' Fields. In the afternoon we will drive to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, to see the Visitation Church where Mary proclaimed her famous "Magnificat". We will also visit the Franciscan Church of St. John the Baptist, the birthplace of John the Baptist. (B/L/D)



Day 4 - Wednesday, June 14: Jerusalem

This morning we will drive to the Mt. of Olives for a panoramic city view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster (commemorating the Our Father) and the Chapel of Ascension. Then walk along the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Continue on to the Garden of Gethsemane to visit the Church of All Nations followed by a stop at the tomb of the Virgin Mary. Then drive to Bethany where Our Lord would come to recuperate in the home of His loving friends, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus before setting out once more on His mission. After visiting the Tomb of Lazarus we will continue on to Jericho, the oldest known city in the Western World. From the top of the ancient "tel", we'll have an excellent view of Elisha's

Fountain, the Mt. of Temptation and the Sycamore tree to remind us of the story of Zaccheus, the tax collector. Then proceed to the Dead Sea for a swim in its salty, mineral-laden waters before returning to Jerusalem. (B/L/D)



Day 5 - Thursday, June 15: Jerusalem

This morning we will enter the Old City through St. Stephen's Gate and visit the Church of St. Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of Flagellation and the Arch of the "Ecce Homo". Then follow the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre to visit the Golgotha and the Tomb of Our Risen Savior. This afternoon we will view from the outside the Temple Area of the Old City featuring the Dome of the Rock and el-Aqsa Mosque and visit the Wailing Wall which is the holiest shrine in the world for Jews. Next proceed to the Mt. Zion to visit the Upper Room which was the location of the Last Supper, Dormition Abbey where Mary "fell into eternal sleep" and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed. This evening enjoy a special Middle Eastern Dinner party with drinks, coffee and tea. (B/D)

Day 6 - Friday, June 16: Jerusalem / Petra

After an early morning Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre we will return to our hotel for breakfast. Then depart Jerusalem after breakfast and drive to the Allenby Bridge to cross into the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. Once in Jordan we will visit the traditional Baptismal Site on the River Jordan and view Elijah's Hill, the place from which the great prophet went up into the sky in a fiery chariot. Then travel south to Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. The highlight of our day will be the descent into magnificent Petra, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. (B/D)

Day 7 - Saturday, June 17: Petra / Amman

This morning will be spent exploring the "Rose Red City" of Petra which is literally carved into the sides of a deep

gorge. The only entrance is through the “Siq”, a narrow slit in the rock enclosed by beautiful limestone cliffs. Riding on horseback (no riding experience required) between the 100 foot cliffs we will see a remarkable sight: temples, tombs, and dwellings chiseled right into the limestone walls. After visiting Petra we will drive to Amman, the capital of Jordan, which like Rome, sprawls over seven hills and was built by the Romans according to a traditional city plan. (B/D)



Day 8 - Sunday, June 18: Amman / Tiberias

Depart Amman and drive north to the Sheikh Hussein border-crossing where we will cross from Jordan back into Israel. Then proceed to the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a scenic boat ride on its waters. Afterwards we will proceed to the town of Tiberias for check-in at our hotel located on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. (B/D)

Day 9 - Monday, June 19: Tiberias

This morning we will drive to Cana of Galilee where Our Lord performed the first miracle - changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here, we’ll invite couples to renew their wedding vows. Then ascend Mt. Tabor to visit the traditional site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. We will then visit Capernaum, home of Our Lord during His ministry, to visit the ancient Synagogue where he taught. Next proceed to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and the Church of Peter’s Primacy where Peter was told “feed my lambs, feed my sheep.” Then drive up to the Mount of the Beatitudes to visit the site of the Sermon on the Mount. (B/L/D)



Day 10 - Tuesday, June 20: Tiberias / Tel Aviv

Depart Tiberias and drive through the rolling hills to Nazareth to visit the Annunciation Church and St. Joseph’s Workshop. Then ascend Mount Carmel, the home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha, to visit Muhraqa which is the site of the sacrifice of Elijah. Continue our drive along the Mediterranean coast to Old Jaffa which was traditionally believed to have been founded by Japheth, son of Noah. Jaffa is one of the oldest towns in the Holy Land, and Peter was here, in the home of Simon the Tanner where he brought Tabitha back from the dead. Visit St. Peter’s Church and walk in the beautiful artists quarter. After dinner we will proceed to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv to catch our late evening return flight home. (B/D)

Day 11 - Wednesday, June 21: Tel Aviv / U.S.A.

Today our Holy Land and Jordan pilgrimage comes to an end as we arrive back in the United States following our overnight flight from Tel Aviv.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to Israel but visas are required for entry to Jordan. The cost of the Jordanian visa is included in the cost of your trip and George's International will be procuring a group visa on your behalf. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Delta Airlines (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing. Fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at www.georgesintl.com. George's International Tours acts only as an intermediary between you and the insurance provider and in no event shall George's International Tours be liable to any person or entity whatsoever for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, compensatory, consequential, or punitive damages related to insurance coverage purchased.
