COVID-19 POLICY

ISRAFI

Please be aware that George's International Tours currently requires all participants on this pilgrimage to be <u>fully vaccinated</u> with one of the CDC-approved vaccines. A person is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after receipt of the second dose in a two-dose series of the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines or two weeks after receipt of a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. If more than 180 days will have passed at any time during your stay in Israel since you were fully vaccinated, you will be required to obtain a booster shot at least two weeks prior to your departure for Israel which will maintain your fully vaccinated status <u>indefinitely.</u> There will be <u>no exceptions</u> made to this vaccination policy for religious or health reasons.

In order to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 on our tours, George's International requires that you provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of your departure for Israel or a negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test taken within 24 hours of your departure for Israel. Obtaining one of these pre-departure COVID-19 tests and the associated cost will be your responsibility. In the event that you obtain a positive result you will not be able to join the pilgrimage until you have completed an 8 day isolation period from the time of your positive test result.

The United States government currently requires that you show evidence of a negative COVID-19 antigen or PCR test which was taken one day prior to your return to the United States before you are allowed to board your return flight home. George's International Tours will assist you in procuring this test in Israel, however the cost will be your responsibility and is expected to be approximately \$40.00 per person (subject to change).

If at any time you become symptomatic of COVID-19 during your pilgrimage we will require that you undergo testing at your own expense as dictated by Israeli law. In the event that you test positive for COVID-19 during the course of your pilgrimage you will be required to go into isolation at your own expense at an official Israeli government COVID isolation facility and for the safety of the other participants you will no longer be allowed to continue with the pilgrimage.

Purchasing comprehensive travel insurance that covers medical treatment for COVID-19 while overseas will be <u>mandatory</u>. Information on the policies we offer is available at <u>georgesintl.com/travel-insurance</u> or you may purchase a policy through a third party if desired.

The entry/exit requirements for Israel and the United States are subject to change and we will notify you of any new regulations that may affect your journey.

We would like to remind you that George's International Tours only acts as an intermediary between you and the other travel suppliers (airlines, hotels, etc.) and in no way assumes responsibility for any COVID-19 related requirements that travel suppliers and governments may impose due to the current pandemic or for any other unforeseen reason.
