GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. Cancellations received after 5PM Pacific Time or on weekends/holidays will be processed the next business day. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to Israel but visas are required for entry to Jordan. The cost of the Jordanian visa is included in the cost of your trip and George's International will be procuring a group visa on your behalf. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Airfare is in economy class on Lufthansa/Austrian Airlines (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares/flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at www.georgesintl.com. George's International Tours acts only as an intermediary between you and the insurance provider and in no event shall George's International Tours be liable to any person or entity whatsoever for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, compensatory, consequential, or punitive damages related to insurance coverage purchased.

Not Included: Gratuities (\$200.00 recommended per person), COVID-19 testing (if required), passport and/or individual visa fees, personal travel insurance, laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of the included meals, additional baggage in excess of airport allowance, optional sightseeing tours, and all expenses of a purely personal nature.

Responsibility Clause: The passenger contract issued by the transportation company shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation company and the passenger. Additional expenses incurred as a result of delay, change of schedules, illness, weather, strikes, hostilities, quarantine, government requisition of hotel space or any other reasons beyond the control of the tour operator or travel agent shall be borne by the passenger. Day 1 - Thursday, March 2: Depart USA

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart the United States for Israel. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

Day 2 - Friday, March 3: Arrive Tel Aviv / Jerusalem

After arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, we will clear customs and then transfer by motorcoach to our hotel in Jerusalem. We check-in and have dinner together. (D)

Day 3 - Saturday: March 4: Jerusalem

This morning we enter the Old City of Jerusalem through St. Stephen's Gate where our first stop is at the Church of St. Anne and the Pools of Bethesda. Next, we make the Way of the Cross, carrying a wooden cross along the streets and among the markets and shops as Jesus did on His journey to Calvary following the Via Dolorosa. We enter the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, and within the church, we visit Golgotha and complete our devotions at the Sacred Tomb of Jesus. In the afternoon we go to the Western Wall or Wailing Wall, where prayers are offered up at these remaining holy stones of the glorious second temple compound. We are aware that now the only structures standing on the Temple Mount are the Moslem Shrines of the Dome of the Rock and the Al Aqsa Mosque. We drive along the walls of the Old City to Mt. Zion. We visit the nearby traditional site of the Upper Room, remembering the Last Supper, a post-Resurrection appearance and Pentecost. Nearby we see Dormition Abbey Church that honors Mary's "falling asleep." We end the day with a visit to St. Peter in Gallicantu, which marks the site of Peter's denial. (B/L/D)



Day 4 - Sunday, March 5: Jerusalem

This morning we drive to the summit of the Mt. of Olives to visit the site of the Ascension of Our Lord and the Church of Pater Noster. Walking the Palm Sunday Road, we will next visit the Chapel of Dominus Flevit. There, too, we have a magnificent panoramic view of the city of

Jerusalem. We continue down the road to the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Basilica of the Agony. This afternoon, proceed to ancient Jericho, which has sites connected with both the Old Testament and the Gospels. We then drive to the Dead Sea for a swim in its salty, mineral-laden waters. Return to our hotel. (B/L/D)



Day 5 - Monday, March 6: Jerusalem

Traveling a short distance south of Jerusalem, we arrive in Bethlehem. We begin our visit to the countryside at Shepherds' Field to remember the angels' glad tidings to the shepherds. Within the town of Bethlehem, we go to venerate the Holy Grotto of the Nativity, as well as the Manger and the Grotto of St. Jerome. We also will visit the Franciscan Church of St. Catherine of Alexandria, site of Bethlehem's Christmas Midnight Mass. This afternoon we travel to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, the birthplace of the Precursor of the Lord, and the Visitation Church, where we recall Mary's prayer of praise: the Magnificat. (B/L/D)

Day 6 - Tuesday, March 7: Jerusalem / Amman

This morning we depart Jerusalem and drive to the Jordan River to recall Our Lord's Baptism by St. John, and to renew our Baptismal Promises. From here we will travel to the Allenby Bridge where we will cross from Israel into Jordan. Continue to Mt. Nebo, which is the site where Moses first viewed the promised land. We will then drive to Amman, the capital of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, and check-in at our hotel. (B/D)

Day 7 - Wednesday, March 8: Amman / Petra / Amman

This morning we will drive south to Petra, one of the most magnificent sites in the Middle East and one of the Seven Wonders. The "Rose Red City" of Petra is carved into the sides of a deep gorge, and the only entrance is through the "Siq," a narrow slit in the rock enclosed by beautiful limestone cliffs. Riding on horseback (no riding experience required) between the 100-foot cliffs, we will

see a remarkable sight: temples, tombs, and dwellings chiseled right into the limestone walls. Following our sightseeing of Petra, we will return to Amman for overnight. (B/D)



Day 8 - Thursday, March 9: Amman / Tiberias

This morning we will check out from our hotel and drive to the Sheikh Hussein border to cross from Jordan back into Israel. From here we proceed to the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a boat ride to Capernaum, the site of many of Jesus' miracles and profound teachings on the Kingdom of God. Nearby are the shrines of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and the Primacy of Peter, both situated in a region referred to as Tabgha. Drive up to the Mount of the Beatitudes, the site of the Sermon on the Mount, where Jesus preached to the people. Then proceed to our hotel in Tiberias, our home for the next two nights. (B/L/D)



Day 9 - Friday, March 10: Tiberias

This morning we drive to Cana, the site of the first miracle. Couples will have the opportunity to renew their marriage vows here. We will then proceed to Nazareth, Jesus' hometown. Here we visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's Church, the site of the home of the Holy Family. The Synagogue Church is about a ten-minute walk from the basilica. In the afternoon we proceed to Mt. Tabor, the mountain where Jesus was transfigured before Peter, James, and John. We return to our hotel in Tiberias for overnight. (B/D)



Day 10 - Saturday, March 11: Tiberias / Tel Aviv

This morning we will drive to Mount Carmel, home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha, to visit Muhraqa which is the site of the sacrifice of Elijah. Then drive along the Mediterranean coast to our hotel located in Tel Aviv. (B/D)

Day 11, Sunday, March 12: Tel Aviv / USA

Today our Holy Land and Jordan pilgrimage comes to an end. Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv early in the morning to catch our return flight home.
