PILGRIMAGE TO FRANCE

September 13-24, 2025

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Sep. 13: Depart USA

Depart the United States on our overnight flight to France.

Day 2 - Sep. 14: Arrive Paris / Lisieux

Upon arrival in Paris this morning we will be met by our tour manager who will be with us throughout our journey in France. Board our motorcoach and drive to Lisieux, the home of St. Therese the "Little Flower of Jesus" to visit the home where she lived as a child, the Carmelite Convent where she was a nun, the Basilica of St. Theresa where we will celebrate Mass, and the Cathedral of St. Peter. Overnight in Lisieux.



Day 3 - Sep. 15: Lisieux / Mont St-Michel

After Mass we will depart Lisieux and drive along the Normandy coast to Colleville-sur-Mer to visit the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial which was established as the first American cemetery on European soil in World War II and contains the graves of 9,389 American soldiers, most of whom lost their lives in the D-Day landings and ensuing operations. We will then drive on to Mont-Saint-Michel, the principal shrine of the Archangel Michael and one of the medieval wonders of Europe. Dinner and overnight will be in Mont-St-Michel.



Day 4 - Sep. 16: Mont St-Michel

Today we will enjoy a complete visit of Mont-Saint-Michel including the Grande Rue, St. Aubert's Chapel, and the Benedictine Abbey, which is perched atop the rock island. Celebrate Mass in the Romanesque Church of St. Michael. Dinner and overnight will be in Mont-St-Michel.



Day 5 - Sep. 17: Mont St-Michel / Orleans

Following breakfast drive through the scenic Loire Valley to Chartres, home to what most believe to be the greatest Gothic cathedral in Europe. The stained glass windows of this Cathedral are world-renowned. Over 150 windows illustrate biblical stories and daily life in the 13th century. After Mass in Chartres, continue to Orleans where Joan of Arc led French troops to victory over the English. Visit the old Cathedral of St. Croix. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Orleans.


Day 6 - Sep. 18: Orleans / Lyon

Drive from Orleans to Nevers where we will visit the Convent of St. Guillard to view the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. Here the Saint spent her life in prayer and solitude following the apparitions of the Blessed Mother to her in Lourdes. Proceed to Paray le Monial where Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary to promote devotions through His Most Sacred Heart. Following Mass at the Visitation Chapel we will visit the Basilica of the Sacred Heart and the Chapel of St. Claude La Colombiere which contains the relics of its namesake saint. We then continue to nearby Lyon for overnight.

Day 7 - Sep. 19: Lyon / Lourdes

After breakfast we will drive to the train station and board our train to Toulouse. Upon arrival in Toulouse we will be met by our waiting motor coach and drive to Lourdes, one of the great pilgrimage shrines in the world. It was here in Lourdes where Our Lady appeared

to St. Bernadette in 1858 proclaiming her the “Immaculate Conception”.



Day 8 - Sep. 20: Lourdes

Today we will have all day to experience the special atmosphere of this beautiful town. Attend Mass at the Grotto of Massabielle, the site where the Virgin appeared. Also visit the Basilica of Pius X (the world’s largest underground church), see the house where Bernadette lived during the Apparitions, and visit several of the sites where the miraculous cures have taken place. This evening we will participate in the Candlelight Procession.

Day 9 - Sep. 21: Lourdes / Paris

Depart Lourdes this morning by train and return to Paris. Upon arrival in Paris we will be picked up at the train station and proceed to the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal at Rue du Bac where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Laboure in 1830. After Mass, we will visit the nearby Saint Vincent de Paul Chapel where the saint’s body is on display in a precious reliquary. Then transfer to our hotel for check-in.



Day 10 - Sep. 22: Paris

This morning we will enjoy a full day tour of the “City of Lights” including visits to the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame

Cathedral, Sainte Chapelle which was built in 1248 to house Our Lord’s Crown of Thorns and other relics, the famous Opera House (outside visit), the Arc de Triomphe (outside visit), Montmartre with its magnificent Basilica of Sacre Coeur, and the Basilica of Saint-Denis which contains the Tomb of St. Louis.

Day 11 - Sep. 23: Paris

This morning we will visit the Louvre Museum where we will explore world famous works of art including the Mona Lisa by Da Vinci. We will then take an excursion outside of Paris to visit the opulent Palace and Gardens of Versailles which were built during the 17th century for the “Sun King” Louis XIV. Visit the State Apartments, the Hall of Mirrors, and the Queen’s Apartments followed by a walk around the manicured gardens. Return to Paris and enjoy a farewell dinner cruise on the Seine River.

Day 12 - Sep. 24: Paris / USA

Transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. Cancellations received after 5PM Pacific Time or on weekends/holidays will be processed the next business day. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for a minimum of 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U.S. citizens. Visas are not required for U.S. citizens. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to determine your visa requirement status. George's International Tours is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Airfare is in economy class on Delta Airlines/Air France (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares/flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at www.georgesintl.com. George's International Tours acts only as an intermediary between you and the insurance provider and in no event shall George's International Tours be liable to any person or entity whatsoever for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, compensatory, consequential, or punitive damages related to insurance coverage purchased.
