



FRANCISCAN EASTER PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

March 25-April 6, 2026



ITINERARY

Day 1 – Wednesday, March 25: Depart USA

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on our overnight connecting flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – Thursday, March 26: Arrive Tel Aviv

After our arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv we'll be met by our Franciscan spiritual director who will accompany us throughout our pilgrimage and make the Scripture come alive as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Board our motorcoach and drive to our hotel in Tel Aviv. (D)



Day 3 – Friday, March 27 / Tiberias

This morning, we will depart Tel Aviv and drive north to Cana of Galilee where Our Lord performed the first miracle changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here, we'll invite couples to renew their wedding vows. Then continue to Nazareth, Our Lord's boyhood town, where we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and visit Joseph's Workshop. Ascend Mt. Tabor to visit the traditional site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. At the conclusion of our sightseeing for the day we will drive to Tiberias and check into our hotel. (B/D)



Day 4 – Saturday, March 28: Tiberias

We will enjoy a scenic boat ride to Capernaum, the home of Our Lord during His ministry, to see the Synagogue where He taught. We will then proceed to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the loaves and fishes, followed by a visit to the Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told "feed my lambs, feed my sheep". Next drive up to the Mount of the Beatitudes to visit the site of the Sermon on the Mount. In the afternoon we will visit Bethsaida, the hometown of Peter, Andrew, and Phillip, and the place where Jesus cured a blind man. Next, we stop at the site of the Miracle of the Swine at Kursi. We end our day with a visit to the Magdala Center to view the ruins of a first century synagogue. (B/L/D)

Day 5 – Sunday, March 29 – PALM SUNDAY: Tiberias / Jerusalem

Following breakfast depart Tiberias and drive to Jerusalem to celebrate Palm Sunday. Join fellow pilgrims from across the world in the Palm Sunday Procession from Bethphage to St. Anne's Church as we follow Jesus' triumphal entrance into Jerusalem. The procession takes us along the same route that Jesus walked and is lined by people with palm branches. We will be among thousands who make their way up to the Mount of Olives. Afterwards we will check in at our hotel. (B/D)



Day 6 – Monday, March 30: Jerusalem

Today we will drive to Bethlehem to visit the Nativity Church which was built above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth, the Manger, the Grotto of St. Jerome, the Church of St. Catherine, and the Shepherds' Fields. (B/L/D)

Day 7 – Tuesday, March 31: Jerusalem

This morning, we will travel through the Judean Wilderness to the Dead Sea for a swim in its salty, mineral laden waters. View the hills of Moab and Mount Nebo and then proceed to the Baptismal Site on the River Jordan where we will have an opportunity to renew our baptismal vows. Our next stop will be in Jericho, the oldest known city in the Western world. From the top of the ancient "tell" we'll have an excellent view of Elisha's Fountain, the Qarantal, the Mount of Temptation and the sycamore tree that recalls the story of Zacchaeus, the tax collector. On the way back to Jerusalem we will make a stop in Bethany where Our Lord would come to recuperate in the home of His loving friends, Mary, Martha and Lazarus before setting out once more on His arduous task. Day 8 – Wednesday, April 1: Jerusalem

After breakfast this morning we will drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the Lord's prayer to His disciples and the Chapel of Ascension. Then walk along the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane to visit and celebrate Mass at the Church of All Nations which commemorates Jesus' Agony in the Garden. In the afternoon we will enter the Old City through St. Stephen's Gate. Visit the Church of St. Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, and the Chapel of Flagellation. Then follow the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre to visit the Golgotha and the Tomb of Our Risen Savior. (B/L/D)



Day 9 – Thursday, April 2 – HOLY THURSDAY: Jerusalem Today we will drive to Mt. Zion to visit the Upper Room, which was the location of the Last Supper, Dormition Abbey where Mary "fell into eternal sleep" and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times before the rooster crowed. This afternoon we will participate in the Holy Thursday Liturgy at the Notre Dame Centre. After dinner there will be an opportunity to participate in a Holy Hour in the Basilica of the Agony. (B/D)

Day 10 – Friday, April 3 – GOOD FRIDAY: Jerusalem

This morning, we will proceed to Emmaus where Our Lord appeared following His resurrection. Continue to the hermitage of St. John in the Desert before returning to Jerusalem. Later in the afternoon we will participate in the Good Friday Liturgy at the Notre Dame Centre. There will be the opportunity to join the "Funeral Procession" in the Holy Sepulchre later this evening. (B/D)

Day 11 – Saturday, April 4 – HOLY SATURDAY: Jerusalem

This morning we will travel to Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation where Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the "Magnificat". We will also visit the Franciscan Church of St. John the Baptist, built in 1885. In the afternoon we will visit the Israel Museum to see the Shrine of the Book which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls and a scale model which depicts Jerusalem as it appeared 2,000 years ago. There will be an opportunity to attend the Easter Vigil Mass at the Notre Dame Centre this evening. This evening enjoy a Middle Eastern dinner at a local restaurant. (B/L/D)

Day 12 – Sunday, April 5 – EASTER SUNDAY: Jerusalem Alleluia! He is risen! After Easter Mass the remainder of the day will be free for personal activities. (B/D)

Day 13 – Monday, April 6: Jerusalem / Tel Aviv / USA

This morning, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv to catch our return flight home.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. Cancellations received after 5PM Pacific Time or on weekends/holidays will be processed the next business day. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for a minimum of 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U.S. citizens. Visas are not required for U.S. citizens, however U.S. citizens are required to obtain an electronic travel authorization (ETA-IL) which can be done online for a fee of approximately \$6.00 per person. Instructions on obtaining the ETA-IL will be provided upon your registration. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to determine your visa requirement or ETA-IL status. George's International Tours is not responsible for visas, passports or other travel documents.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Airfare is in economy class on Swiss Air/Lufthansa (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares/flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at <u>www.georgesintl.com</u>.
